Black Wall Street was located in the suburb of Tulsa Oklahoma as former Slaves migrated from the Deep South following the abolition of Slavery. The institution of segregationist Jim Crow Laws limited the opportunities available to former Slaves however, and the trek to Oklahoma on foot, by wagon, horse and train was in search of Abolition's promise of Liberty, Equality and Opportunity .
