The best way is to remove both the battery cables from your car battery and leave them off for 12 minutes. Then put the battery cables back on and tighten them up tight. Take your key and put it into the driver door. Lock and unlock the door 3 times. This should deactivate the anti theft system.

Leave the key in the ignition for 10 minutes. Turn the key to the "off" position -- and leave it there for 20 seconds -- after the anti-theft light stops blinking. This disables the Passlock system; it is ready to "relearn" your key. Remove the key. Put the key back in the ignition, and start the vehicle.
