These guidelines are used by schools, institutions, and facilities participating in the National School Lunch Program (and USDA Foods in Schools), School Breakfast Program, Special Milk Program for Children, Child and Adult Care Food Program and Summer Food ...

Income Eligibility Guidelines | USDA-FNS

If your child ' s application for free or reduced meals was approved last year, you still must reapply for the new school year. You do not have to be a U.S. citizen to qualify for free or reduced price meals. For military families, basic pay, cash bonuses and any cash value allowances (off-base housing, food, clothing) must be reported as income.

Free or reduced school meals: Income eligibility ...

Children from families with incomes at or below 130 percent of the Federal poverty level are eligible for free meals. Those with incomes between 130 and 185 percent of the Federal poverty level are eligible for reduced price meals. Schools may not charge children more than 40 cents for a reduced price lunch. How do children qualify for free and reduced price meals?

Effective July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021, participants from households with incomes at or below the following levels may be eligible for free or reduced-price meals or free milk. Note: The new income calculations are based on annual figures and the following formulas: Monthly = annual income divided by 12; Twice Per Month = annual income divided by 24; Every Two Weeks = annual income divided by 26; and Weekly = annual income divided by 52.

The Department's guidelines for free meals and milk and reduced price meals were obtained by multiplying the year 2019 Federal income poverty guidelines by 1.30 and 1.85, respectively, and by rounding the result upward to the next whole dollar.

Free and Reduced School Lunch Eligibility | Department of ...

Household size and income is the most common way to determine eligibility. For example, a child from a family of four is eligible for free school meals if the household ' s current annual income is below \$34,060. If the family ' s annual income is between \$34,061 and \$48,470, the child is eligible for reduced-price meals.
