Having settled on a standard gauge of 5 ft 3 ins., numerous lines snaked out across the landscape to eventually connect large centres and ports, each sponsored by independent concerns, though amalgamations and takeovers soon occurred.

The track gauge adopted by the mainline railways in Ireland is 1,600 mm. This unusual track gauge is otherwise found only in Australia, in the states of Victoria, southern New South Wales and South Australia, as well as in Brazil. The Grand Duchy of Baden State Railway used this gauge between 1840 and 1855, as did the Canterbury Provincial Railways in New Zealand, until conversion to the 1,067 mm gauge in the 1860s. The Launceston and Western Railway in Tasmania also used this gauge from 1871, u

In the 1870s the Guinness brewery had expanded so much that internal transport was becoming difficult so construction of a narrow gauge railway network serving the entire brewery, with a gauge of 1ft 19in.
