Significance of Research in Social Sciences—MBA—

Some specific limitations associated with using quantitative methods to study research problems in the social sciences include: Quantitative data is more efficient and able to test hypotheses, but may miss contextual detail; Uses a static and rigid approach and so employs an inflexible process of discovery;
