Their name comes from the region which is frequently – and incorrectly – referred to as a "country". Sumer was never a cohesive political entity, however, but a region of city -states each with its own king.

The first settlement in southern Mesopotamia was Eridu. The Sumerians claimed that their civilization had been brought, fully formed, to the city of Eridu by their god Enki or by his advisor, Adapa U-an. The fi
