The main trunk of the tomato plant is comprised of three parts. The first, the shoot apical meristem (SAM), is the actively growing portion located at the crown of the plant. The second portion consists of primary tissues, newly grown stem just behind the SAM. All other stem-wood is referred to as secondary tissue, or old growth.

Three Stages Of Growth In Tomato Plants - Tomato Growing

When the first fruits begin to form, the plant will produce side-shoots in between the main stem and the leaf stems. These side shoots (see arrows in diagram on the right) should be removed by pinching them out with the fingers. If allowed to grow they will produce a mass of foliage but few tomatoes.

The spacing for tomato plants depends on the type of tomato plant and how you want it to grow (namely, structured or unstructured growth). For determinate tomato plants, these can be planted anywhere between 2 to 2.5 feet (60-75cm) apart, spacing rows of plants apart by around 4 feet (120cm).
